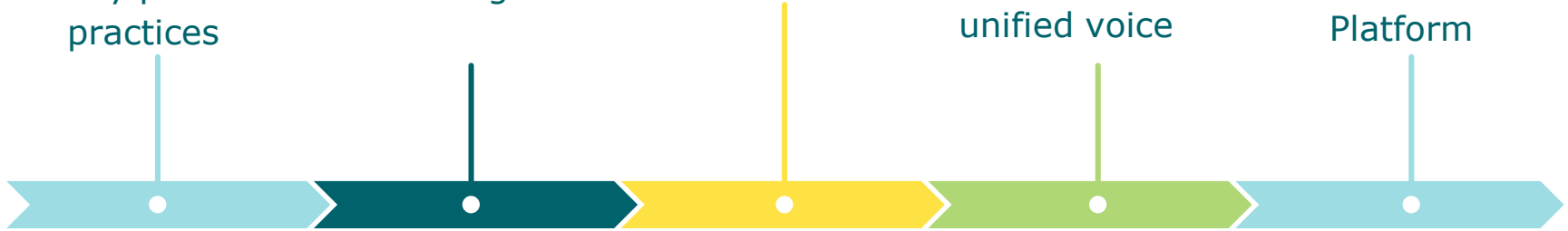
Roadmap of action to UNFSS
